

Jasper Lake

Jasper is a 195 acre lake with very high water clarity (visibility is 14'). It has three large and two small islands. The past five seasons have produced good-sized small & large-mouth bass (4-1/2 to 5 lbs.) plus a wide range of sizes in northern pike (ranging from 1 to 10+ lbs), bluegill, & perch. Some nice sized walleyes have also been caught. Many of our guests practice catch & release to ensure future years of great fishing. These species along with trout are available in many lakes surrounding Jasper as well. You are limited only by your ambition.



We have an abundance of wildlife that lives in and around the waters of Jasper including moose, deer, bear, beavers, wolves, fox, otters, fishers, pine martens, mink, nesting loons, ducks, seagulls, eagles, osprey, great blue herons, bitterns, ravens, ruffed grouse, and a myriad of songbird species. Your chances of seeing many of these animals are excellent.



Northwind Lodge is the only resort on Jasper Lake and owns approximately 3500 feet of shoreline. There are only a few other summer residences. A 94 rod portage leads you to Moose Lake from Jasper. Jasper is about 1 mile from the BWCAW line and about 4.5 miles from the Canadian Border.

Historically, Jasper Lake has always been known for its peaceful coexistence with the wilderness at its doorstep. We, at Northwind Lodge, neither encourage nor allow water skiing or jet skiing by any of our guests.

Travel Times: To help you plan your travel time, Northwind Lodge is approximately 11 hours from Chicago, 10 hours from Des Moines, 5 hours from Minneapolis/St. Paul, and 2.5 hours from Duluth. Please schedule your trip to arrive here between **3:00 PM and 8:00 PM.** Have a safe trip!

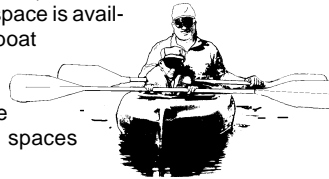

**All boat, motor and canoe rentals are available on a calendar day basis only. Half-day rentals are not available.

Private boats and canoes may be launched at our landing for a flat, weekly fee of \$25.00 per boat (canoes and kayaks are no extra charge). If space is available at our designated private boat dock, you may use it. Otherwise, private boats will be parked on shore. Northwind boats will be parked at their assigned dock spaces when not in use.



Boat Transportation to Surrounding Waters

Northwind Lodge will transport the boat that comes with your cabin to Ojibway/Triangle or Tofte Lake so that you may try fishing or exploring some different waters in our area. Round-trip delivery cost is \$20. If you want haul one of our canoes by yourself, we'll set you up with a foam block kit and show you how to use it on your vehicle for no additional charge. Then you can go all over the place on your schedule.

Boat/Canoe Substitutions

One assigned aluminum boat is included with each cabin rental at no additional cost. You may substitute an aluminum canoe instead of the boat for the week, as long as you tell us your preference at check-in. Ultra-light kevlar or duralite canoe upgrades are available for a fee. Just ask us!

Northwind Lodge - Summer (May thru Sept.) Cabin Descriptions and Rates effective 2007

Our mainland cabins are housekeeping units. They come equipped with kitchen facilities including a gas range, electric refrigerator, basic cooking utensils, dishes, silverware, dish soap, & kitchen towels; bathrooms with showers, lavatories, flush toilets, & toilet tissue. All units are carpeted. Microwaves, automatic coffee makers, and BBQ grills are also included. Garb. bags & all bed linens are provided. A boat with its own dock-space is provided with each cabin. Note: Rustic Cabins have differing amenities. **Please bring your own bath towels, soap, and paper towels, since these items are not provided.**

Modern Housekeeping Cabins

Waterfall Run-Cabin #2

A comfortable cabin next to our picturesque waterfall. Sleep to the peaceful sounds of Jasper Creek. This cabin has a knotty pine interior with some log work plus an outside deck, picnic table and BBQ grill. Two bedrooms with two double beds and a set of bunks. Sleeps up to 6 people. **Base rate includes up to first 4 people and \$60.00 each additional person.**

Otter's Pointe-Cabin #3

A cozy, knotty pine cabin overlooking Jasper Lake. Perfect for two people seeking to get away from it all. Can sleep up to three with use of the daybed. One bedroom with a double bed. Cabin has a deck & private yard. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people, \$60 for an additional person.**

Red Rock Ridge-Cabin #4

A picturesque cabin overlooking lake & beach area. Beautiful view & an open, fresh-air feel. Skylight. Unique blend of old log and new knotty pine flatter each other. Gas grill & picnic table on spacious deck. Two bedrooms; two double beds & one twin bed. 5 people maximum. **Base Rate includes up to 3 people, \$60.00 each additional person.**

Loon-Call Lookout-Cabin #5

Newly Remodeled! An enchanting cabin overlooking the lake by the beach area. Rustic dark pine interior with lots of windows. One couple of our guests stayed in this cabin for over 35 summers in a row! Will sleep up to three with daybed. Deck & BBQ grill. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people; \$60 for an additional person.**

Eagle's Creek Haven-Cabin #6

A large, roomy cabin with lots of knotty pine, large windows, a deck, and a view of the lake. Located creekside. Has its own picnic table and outdoor grill. Three bedrooms. One double bed and four twin beds. This cabin is very popular; many of our returning guests request it specifically. **Base Rate includes up to 4 people; \$60.00 each additional person.**

Portage Hideaway-Cabin #7

A quaint, comfortable cabin with two bedrooms only 75' from the water's edge. Sleeps up to 4 people with one double bed and two twin beds. Off by itself, this cabin has log work &

knotty pine. Counter-top range. Picnic table, BBQ grill, & deck. **Base Rate includes up to 3 people; \$60.00 for an additional person per week.**

Voyageurs Villa-Cabin #8

A large, two-story cabin located creekside. Roomy living/dining areawith log work and knotty pine. Picnic table & BBQ grill. Four bedrooms with six twin beds and one double. Sleeps eight. A highly requested choice. **Base Rate includes up to 4 people; \$60.00 each additional person.**

Apartment Units

TreetopHaus (TTH)

A newer unit high in the trees and a part of the Lodge building. Separate external entrance. Kitchenette. Plush carpeting, large sliding windows, and lots of knotty pine make this a very comfortable refuge in the wilderness. Bathroom with shower. One bedroom with a double bed; Two day-beds in the living room. Sleeps up to four people. Located 300 feet from the beach. Air conditioner. Picnic table & BBQ grill. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people; \$60.00 each additional person.**

GuestHaus (GH)

A roomy, well-equipped apartment with its own driveway, grill, and picnic table. Private entrance. Carpeting, bathroom with shower. Two bedrooms; one with one double and two twin beds. Knotty pine accents. Complete kitchen facilities. Sleeps up to four people. A non-smoking unit. **NEW--Satellite television!** Located about 350' from the beach area. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people; \$60 each additional person.**

Rustic Cabins

For vacationers seeking a unique wilderness adventure not found elsewhere, these cabins provide comfortable remote hideaways with more privacy. Both have basic cooking and eating utensils, bed & kitchen linens, T.P., dish soap, and outhouses. Complete bathrooms with hot showers, lavatories and flush toilets are available on the mainland near the Lodge.

The Island Adventure (Island)

An inviting cabin on a magnificent 7 1/2 acre island. Log and knotty pine interior, deck, gas lights, gas range, cooler, glass front wood heater, and outdoor gas grill on the deck. No electricity. Refrigerator on mainland. Convenient drinking water on mainland. Rate includes aluminum canoe. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people maximum to insure a low impact on the ecosystem of the Island. Grandpa's Log Cabin (GLC) This was the first cabin built here in 1939 by Frank Baltich, Sr. All log construction on a steep shore of Jasper Lake, accessible only by hiking trail or water. Wake up to a spectacular view of Jasper Lake only 10 paces from the bedroom windows. This cabin has electric lighting, gas range, electric refrigerator, coffee-maker, toaster, cold running water, outdoor gas grill. 1 double bed, 1 twin, & a couch. **Base Rate includes up to 2 people; \$60 each additional person.**

RESERVATIONS - A \$200.00 deposit per cabin/unit per week is required for a confirmed reservation. We prefer a credit card over the phone. Your reservation will be automatically terminated if we do not receive your deposit within ten (10) days after you've made your initial reservation. To ensure an immediate confirmation, we'll gladly accept your Visa, Mastercard, Discover, or Am.Ex. card over the phone. Mailed personal checks and money orders are acceptable as well.

Reservation Cancellation Policy

Deposits will be refunded minus a \$50.00 administrative fee on all reservations that are cancelled over 60 days prior to your scheduled check-in date. Cancellations in less than 60 days will forfeit the entire deposit with no exceptions. Deposits may be deferred for up to one year in the event of personal emergency cancellations.

To avoid any misunderstanding, you are responsible for any and all time you have reserved, and your deposit is applicable to the last night of your reservation only. No rate alterations will be allowed for your early departure during your reserved time.

CHECK-IN, CHECK-OUT

Check-in is after 3:00 PM Reservations will be held only until 8:00 PM on your scheduled arrival date unless we hear from you explaining your delay. Should you arrive in Ely before our 3:00 PM check-in time, please call ahead at 365-5489 to see if your cabin is ready before driving out to the Lodge.

Check-out is 9:00 AM and no later so that we may prepare the resort for incoming guests. A late charge of \$10.00 will be charged for each half hour beyond the check-out time of 9:00 AM. Please talk to us in advance if you need a later check-out time!
